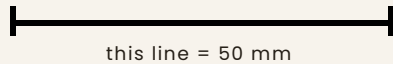

Print this at **Actual Size (100%)**. In the print dialog switch off "Fit to page" or "Scale to fit". Then confirm **both** checks below are exact — if not, the page was scaled and the circles will read wrong.

on this outline
EDGES SHOULD LINE UP

Match a ring you already own

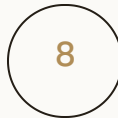
Slide the ring over the outlines until its **inside edge** sits on a circle. The large number is the **Pakistani size**; the US, UK and millimetre figures are beneath it. Between two? Take the larger.

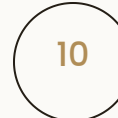

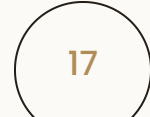

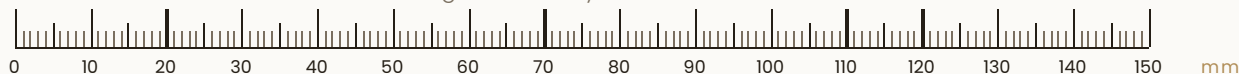

Or measure the finger

Wrap a thin strip of paper or a length of thread around the base of the finger, snug but not tight and passing over the knuckle. Mark where it meets, lay it flat along the rule below, and read the length in millimetres — that is your inside circumference. Your Pakistani size is that figure less forty.

A few notes. Fingers are smallest in the cool of the morning and largest by evening — measure at day's end with warm hands. A band wider than about 6 mm reads tighter, so size up one. Size to clear the knuckle; a slight looseness at the base can be corrected.
